### Questions and Responses

1. Does the contract require any fixed full-time labor at the collection sites?  
*Yes.*
2. Is Merced County coordinating the CESQG deliveries? If so, does the County prepare that for the 180-day pickup request?  
*No. The Contractor is responsible for coordinating all CESQG deliveries.*
3. Is there any prevailing wage or wage requirements for the event-based and scheduled pickups at the fixed facilities?  
*No.*
4. For the 180-day pickup request, will contractor be sorting and preparing waste during that pick-up or will the material be prepared at point of collection by the county (Or fixed FT contractor)?  
*Contractor will be responsible for sorting and preparing waste during pick-ups. Paint is the only material that MCRWMA packages.*
5. What is the estimated annual expenditure for this contract?  
*The estimated annual expenditure ranges between \$75,000-\$90,000.*
