Subject: Submittal of the Merced County Association of Governments Administrative Modification #7 to the 2009 FTIP

Dear Joanne:

Enclosed for your review and approval is the Administrative Modification #7 to the 2009 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). Please disregard the April 9, 2009 letter on the same subject and consider this one instead. Modification #7 meets all applicable transportation planning requirements per 23 CFR Part 450 and 40 CFR Part 93.

Administrative Modification #7 increased the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act RSTP Lump Sum Program (ARRA-RSTP) from \$4,791,906 to \$5,054,316, which was the revised estimate distributed by Caltrans on March 10, 2009 (see attachment).

On March 19, 2009 the MCAG Governing Board of Directors approved Administrative Modification #7 to the 2009 FTIP. The CTIPS database has been modified.

This programming change is consistent with Caltrans' procedures for federal statewide transportation program (FSTIP/FTIP) modifications, administrative amendment (type 1) and does not require an air quality conformity analysis or determination. The change does not adversely affect the timely implementation of Transportation Control Measures (TCMS). These projects are exempt, non-regionally significant projects.

The proposed modification is consistent with the Merced County 2007 Regional Transportation Plan, adopted May 17, 2007 and amended January 15, 2009.

As amended, the FTIP is financially constrained. The financial constraint documentation will be updated to reflect changes made by this administrative modification in the next formal amendment.

Included with this letter are two hard copies of Administrative Modification #7 to the 2009 FTIP. Administrative modification #7 to the 2009 FTIP is available online on the MCAG website at www.mcagov.org.
