Assurance of Timely Project Delivery**

AB 1012 has been enacted into State Law in part to provide for the “timely use” of State and Federal funds; and the (City/County) \_\_\_\_\_ is able to apply for and receive Federal funding under the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) Program.

Failure to meet project delivery deadlines may be deemed as sufficient cause for the MCAG Board to terminate an agency’s project and reprogram CMAQ funds as deemed necessary.

The (City/County) \_\_\_\_\_ does direct its management and engineering staff to ensure all projects are carried out in a timely manner as per the requirements of AB 1012.
