

Request: \$15,000,000 for the construction of an aquatic center, providing swim access to the Los Banos community.

Description: Summer temperatures in Los Banos can regularly exceed 100 degrees and the Los Banos area does not currently offer a community pool for recreational swimming or swimming lessons. Los Banos has been without a swim center for the past ten years. An aquatics facility is the most publicly requested recreation amenity in Los Banos. An aquatics center could feature pool access for recreational and competitive activities. The aquatics center could be part of a larger regional complex or operate as a stand-alone facility.

The City of Los Banos is seeking support for the following:

1. An aquatics swim center

Necessity: Los Banos has been without a swim center for over 10 years. This has meant no access for seniors swim classes or youth swim lessons. With a large canal system throughout the City, it is important for youth members to learn how to swim. Los Banos is considered a “disadvantaged community” by the State of California and an aquatic center would help serve low-income members of the community. A splash pad would provide free access to residents and visitors.

Beneficiaries:

- Youth, adults and seniors in the Los Banos community and surrounding communities.
