

# YOUTH CENTER REHABILITATION

#### **Request:**

\$1,750,000 for Atwater Youth Center rehabilitation and improvements.

### **Description:**

The City of Atwater took possession of the Castle Youth Center after the military decommissioned Castle Air Force Base in 1993. At that time, the city was able to do a minor renovation to the facility. Unfortunately, due to budgeting the Center has remained in almost the same condition as it was in the 90's with few upgrades. As it stands, the building currently houses all citywide and various regional youth programs.



#### **Necessity:**

The building needs to be upgraded to meet current American with Disabilities Act standards. The current youth center is no longer functional due to many compounding factors. Several of the doors as well as the restrooms no longer meet ADA requirements and are in need of repair. The flooring is worn and is need of upgrade for best use for athletic engagement.

## **Rehabilitation and Improvements:**

Plans for rehabilitation and improvements include making the building accessible, safe, functional, and provide an environment for local youth to engage in physical activities and offering educational opportunities.
