

Description:

The City of Livingston provides water to 15,000 residents along with businesses and industries located within the city limits. The purpose of this project is to supplement the City of Livingston's groundwater supply with treated surface water from the Merced Irrigation District (MID) by constructing a pipeline from the existing MID surface water transmission pipeline to Livingston's water distribution system, along with a booster pump station. This project will conserve groundwater through in-lieu recharge and provide safe drinking water to Livingston's community. Total project costs is \$8.5 million.

Request:

\$6,000,000 used for construction of a pipeline to connect the City of Livingston's water distribution system to the existing MID transmission main. State/local match = \$2.5 million.
